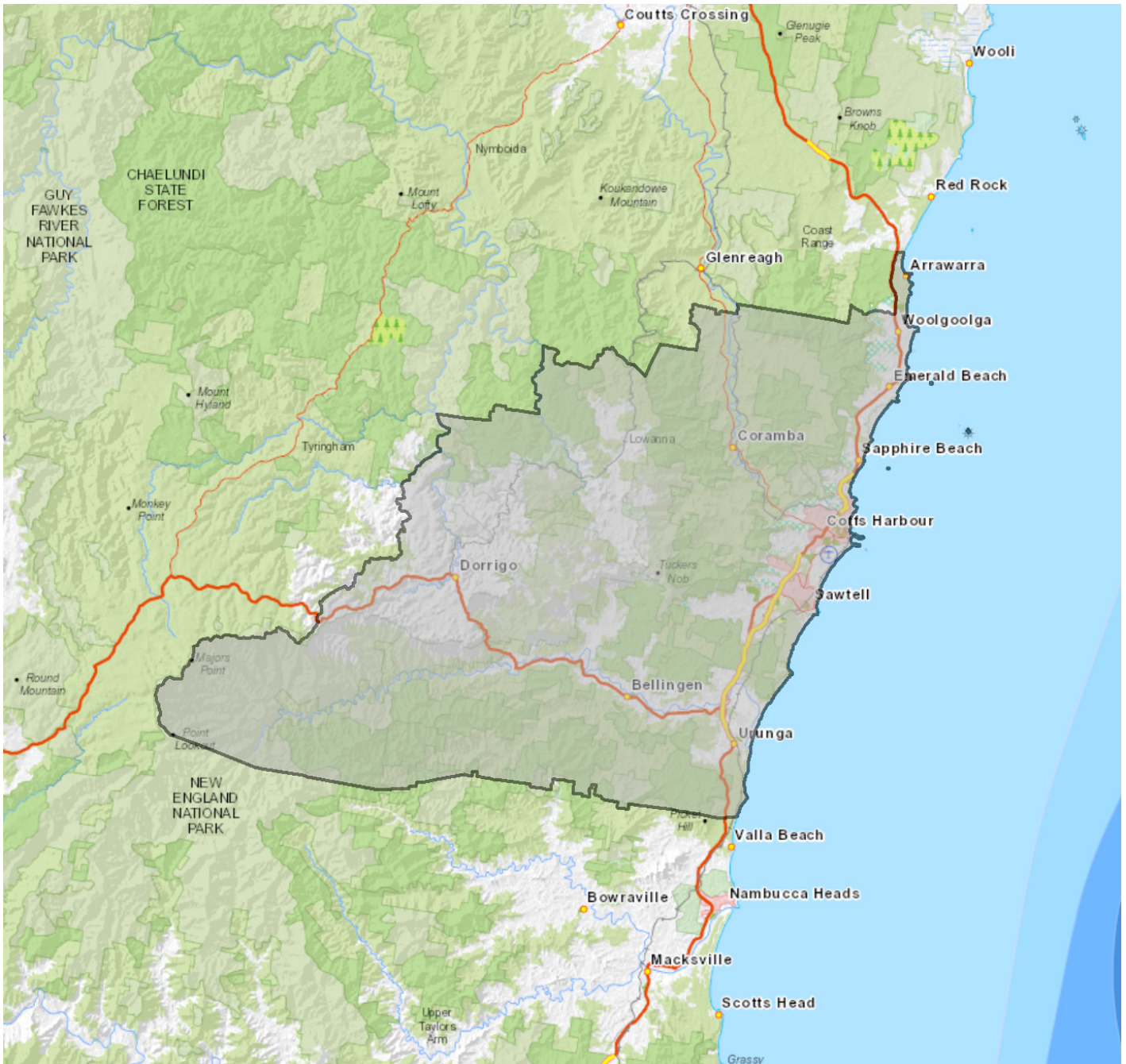

COFFS HARBOUR

Coffs Harbour is located on the north coast of NSW. Coffs Harbour is an area that attracts many tourists from Sydney and Melbourne coming in search of warmer weather. Coffs Harbour has the most liveable climate in Australia and is nestled between a high mountain backdrop teeming with national parks including Dorrigo and Solitary Island National Parks, dozens of beaches and the Big Banana.

In comparison to the 2011 census, the population of the radio licence area of Coffs Harbour has increased by 3.56% to 85,635. Over 56% of the population is aged over 40 years. The birthplace for 82% of the population was Oceania including Australian, New Zealander, Indigenous and Islander persons.

Of the 16,330 people attending an educational institution, 44% were either in infants or primary, 33% were attending a secondary educational institution, 11% attending University or another tertiary institution and 12% attending TAFE. Of the 34,199 people who already have a tertiary qualification, 32% have a degree and 68% have a certificate, diploma or another tertiary qualification.

Of the total dwellings (32,088) in Coffs Harbour, 39% of dwellings are owned outright and 29% are mortgaged. Private rental properties represent 25% of total dwellings.

25% of the total households (32,028) in Coffs Harbour have a household income range between \$21,000 – \$41,999pa; 26% between \$42,000 – \$77,999pa; and 11% between \$78,000 – \$103,999pa.

All major banks, car dealers, fast-food restaurants and an extensive selection of national retail and chain stores are represented in the city.

AGRICULTURE

The main industries in Coffs Harbour are tourism, fishing and agriculture. Over half of the farmland in the area produces bananas, avocados or other tropical fruit such as mangoes. The area produced over 302 thousand kilograms of avocados, 26 thousand kilograms of orchard fruit and over 10 thousand kilograms of nuts.

There are over 14 thousand beef and 5 thousand dairy cattle, and over 266 thousand sheep and lambs supported in the region.

EMPLOYMENT

50% of the total labour force of 37,653 is employed full time. The main industries of employment are:

- Education and Training/Health Care and Social Assistance;
- Wholesale Trade/Retail Trade/Accommodation and Food Services; and
- Manufacturing/Electricity Gas Water and Waste Services/Construction.

The tourist industry has probably had the biggest impact on employment. A vast majority of the workforce (23%) is employed in the Retail or Wholesale Trade and Accommodation industries.
